

I have had requests to do an early service again this week.

Last week we had Sunday worship three different ways. A ten o'clock service where everyone was masked. An eleven o'clock service where we followed Alabama distancing guidelines on masks. And a video of the eleven o'clock service that was on our Facebook site. No masks required. Some probably even watched from their couch while wearing pajamas.

The first two services had about the same number of people. Twenty or so at each. The on line version has reached 124 people to date. And that number is half what we have done other Sundays on line. Lowered number is because of my failure to get us going on line at eleven. We ended up recording the service and then posting it a little after noon. Sorry. We will try to do better. Let us know if you want to help with the video process.

So here is what I think we will do for Sundays in September. We will try to do all three ways – 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. with that service being a little longer and being live streamed.

I do not want to continue with two Sunday services after that. **One service only after September.** We are very open to what time that service will be. Several like the idea of all of us meeting at 10 or 10:30 instead of 11:00. You can be thinking about that. I am not sure what we would do about masks. I would love to know that by then we can throw masks away. And that we have Sunday Schools going full force.

I think that we have all learned to wait and see. For now, starting this Sunday, September 6:

**10:00 Service. 30 minutes. Everyone masked.**

**11:00 Service. 45 minutes. Alabama distancing guidelines followed.**
